

Subject: Delay in submission of pension claims in respect of Defence Civilians.

Reference: CGDA UO NO. 5192/AT-P(Report) dated 18.03.2016

After studying the report for the month of February, 2016, it is observed that about 11% to 23% pension cases (other than VRS) were submitted to the PCDA at belated stage by the Head of offices of various Defence organisations/Establishments.

2. It may be appreciated that the delay in submission of pension cases causes undue hardship to the pensioners and dependent family members. In order to check these delays, the procedure and time limits for submission of pension papers to the Accounts Authorities have been prescribed in Rule 56 to 76 CCS(Pension) Rules, 1972. It is seen from the monthly report that some cases were received in PCDA beyond the prescribed time limit, this would result in delay in grant of pension and subsequent payments by the PDA.

3. It is reiterated that the Head of Offices who are solely responsible for timely submission of pension papers to PCDA(P) Allahabad must ensure that the timelines prescribed in the CCS(Pension) Rules, 1972 in respect of pension claims are strictly adhered to.
